Regulations

1. Rules and Participating Conditions

The meeting will be staged according to the rules (WB and RO) and the anti-doping regulations (ADO) of the German Swimming Federation (DSV). For handicapped swimmers with the appropriate classification of evidence the rules and regulations of the German Disabled Sports Federation (DBS) will be in force additionally. The meeting is open to all clubs and teams of federations associated to FINA. For German clubs we refer to the special regulations of the DSV (please see also the German version of this invitation).

When submitting the entries, the club has to confirm that its athletes are healthy to do sports.

2. Entries

2.1. Advance notification

Please fill out the form until **15.09.2017**, so that we can arrange all required preparations for your stay in Aachen. If you encounter problems using the form, please contact us directly.

If possible, please send your entries as DSV-6.0 or Lennex 3.0 data files. Corresponding templates are available on the competition website (<http://isf.asv06.de>).

As **entry times**, use only official results obtained in the timespan of 03.10.2016 by 03.10.2017!

Please send your entries by Monday, **03.10.2017**. If you don't receive a confirmation of your entries within 24h after submitting, please contact us immediately (by phone).

2.3. Limitation of entries

We limit the number of heats **in the best interest of a high-class competition** (refer also to column „L.H.“ in the table on page 2). The swimmers with the fastest entry times (please also see paragraph 2.2.) will be accepted. Additional 8 swimmers will be put on the reserve list. The corresponding starting lists (incl. reserve swimmers) will be published on 05.10.2017.

The given **standard times** in the program are based on the results of the last years and shall be understood as follows: you will be likely accepted if your entry time is below the standard time.

We reserve the right to reserve 2 starting places per event for the swimmers of the organizing ASV06 e.V. We reserve the right to reserve 2 starting places per event for paralympic swimmers. We also reserve the right to cancel the mixed medley relay in case of too few entries or, in the case of more than 6 entries, to reject teams. In this case we would contact the teams immediately after the entry deadline.

2.4. Entry money

The entry fee is 12,00 € for each individual start and 20,00 € for the mixed medley relay (competition-no. 23). The entry-fee **can only be transferred** to the bank account of the Aachener Schwimmverein 06.

The entry money (incl. reserve list) shall be transferred **after publication of the startlists until 06.10.2017**, otherwise the club/team is not allowed to start. The overpaid money (from athletes on the reserve list) will be paid back via bank transfer. We therefore ask you to include your bank details (IBAN and BIC/SWIFT-Code) in your notification.

If a club does not participate, the duty of payment still persists.

3. Competition

The meeting will be held at "Schwimmhalle Ost", St.-Josefs-Platz 8, 52068 Aachen (Germany). The pool consists of 6 lanes and is 25m long (short course). The lanes are separated by wave-killing lines. The temperature of water is at least 26° Celsius, the depth varies from 1.80m – 3.80m.

Electronic timing (System Omega) will be used. The one-start-rule will be used (see §125 sec. 6 WB (DSV)). The start list will be arranged according to §121-§123 WB (DSV). The start signal will be given in English.

4. Referees

The referees will be organized by the organising club in cooperation with "swimming district Aachen".

5. Rewards

The ranking only consists of open class. The three best swimmers of each competition receive medals. The prize money is regulated by paragraph 9 of this invitation.

6. Mixed-medley relay

The relay has to be swum in the ordinary order: back-breast-fly-free. Two women and two men have to swim, but their order is arbitrary. Also teams on a national or federational level are allowed.

7. Accommodation

For your lodging we have arranged some special arrangements with hotels in Aachen. In order to receive the cheaper price, we suggest making an early reservation.

8. Ticket reservation

Due to the big abundance of visitors we recommend to make a reservation:

The ticketing starts on 15.09.2017, after publication of the startlists. The remaining tickets can be bought at the door.

9. Prize money

Up to **8,650 €** in prize money will be awarded. The money is distributed according to the following system:

A. Mixed-medley relay

1 st place:	240 €
2 nd place:	120 €
3 rd place:	80 €

B. Specialists Reward:

There is prize money available in the following categories for men and women:

100 + 200 m	butterfly	(fly specialist)
100 + 200 m	backstroke	(back specialist)
100 + 200 m	breaststroke	(breast specialist)
100 + 200 m	freestyle	(free specialist)
400 + 800/1500 m	freestyle	(long distance specialist)
200 + 400 m	ind. medley	(medley specialist)

In each category the highest score will be established according to the FINA points-table (edition 2016, short course). If a swimmer starts in prelim and final, the better time will be taken. In each category the three best swimmers (male and female) get a prize money of **100 €, 50 € and 30 €** respectively.

C. Sprint Reward:

In the prelims of all 50m-competitions and 100m ind. medley the 8 fastest swimmers will get points: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1. The three best swimmers with the highest score from all 5 competitions will be awarded a prize money of **250 €, 150 € and 100 €** respectively

D. Special Reward:

The swimmer who gains the highest score in a single race (FINA table edition 2015, short course) will get a prize money of **250 €** each. Men and women are awarded separately.

E. Record Reward

For new Festival records 50 € will be awarded. If no new record is set up, the prize money will be passed into a record jackpot. This means that next year the prize money will be 100 € for this event and so on. But the jackpot is limited to **150 €**. You can see the amount for each event in the program table.

If a record is set up in a prelim, the prize money will only be given when the swimmer starts in the final of this competition. If more than one swimmer breaks the record, only the fastest swimmer will get the reward and will be published as record holder.

The swimmer has to pick the prize money up. Otherwise it goes into possession of the ASV06.

This invitation was shown to the swimming officer of Swimming District Aachen (Schwimmbezirk Aachen), Gabi Dreiner.

In case of any disagreement between this invitation and the German version, the German version is the relevant one.
